## TOO SICK FOR SCHOOL

**FEVER:** Stay home if your temperature is 100 deg F or above. You should be fever free without medication for 24 hours before returning to school

**VOMITING:** If you have vomited in the last 12 hours you should stay home

**RED EYES:** If your eyes are stuck shut in the AM, are bright red or have a discharge you need to see a doctor for treatment. This may be a highly contagious eye infection. You may return to school once you have been on antibiotics for 24 hours
